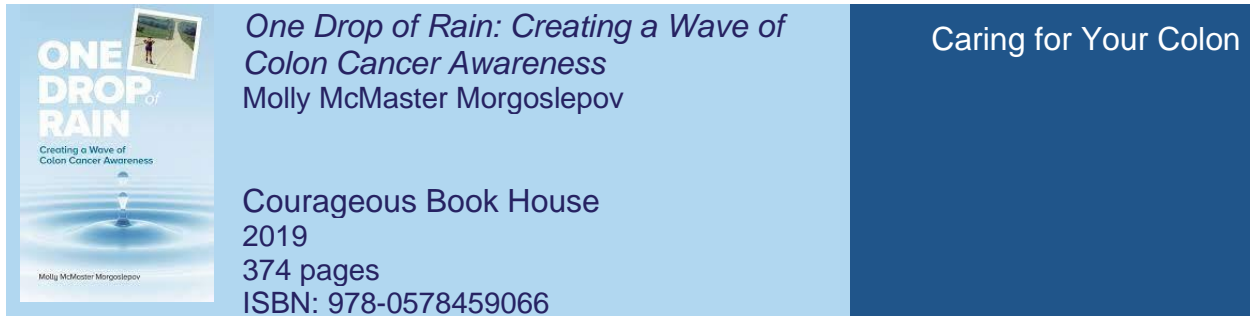


Discussion Guide
