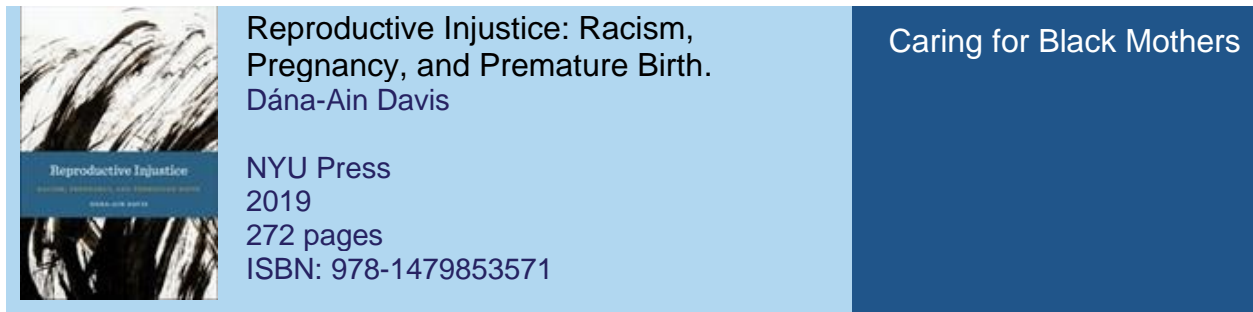


Discussion Guide
